

BAF Scholarship Application Deadline: Thursday, April 1, 2010

This is an alphabetical list of scholarships available through funds established at the Beckley Area Foundation (BAF). This information is also available at www.beckleyareafoundation.com. Read each description carefully to determine if you qualify. Included with each description is information about: a) where to apply for each scholarship, b) which application form to use, and c) where to obtain that appropriate form. If you are unsure—ask questions! Use the correct application form! Be sure to note any alternate application deadline or renewal information.

This year the Beckley Area Foundation application is available for download at our website. This BAF application cannot be completed on line. it must be postmarked by April 1st. As scholarships are reviewed by a number of selection committees, if using the BAF application you will need to submit one application for each scholarship you are seeking. If you do not have access to a computer speak with your high school guidance office or contact BAF 304-253-3806.

New this year, is a quick reference guide to scholarships. Beginning on page 18, scholarships are listed by school, county, field of study, etc. Make sure to read the detailed individual scholarship descriptions to insure you meet all criteria and follow the correct application process.

The scholarship recipient must provide the address of the school business office as scholarship checks are mailed directly to the college or university. The address of the donor or fund representative will be provided so that a thank you may be forwarded by the student.

Appalachian Scholarship

Eligibility

- High school graduate from Appalachian coal fields enrolling in an engineering program at a technical college or university such as Carnegie Mellon, Georgia Tech, MIT, Cal Tech, Colorado School of Mines, or the engineering schools of Virginia Tech and Texas A&M.
- Applicants planning to attend engineering schools not listed must contact the BAF office (253-3806) to determine if it is a donor approved program.
- The recipients are to be selected based on their academic potential.

Renewable: Yes; re-apply annually.

Eligibility

- Raleigh County students attending Mountain State University.
- Pursuing a health science/medical related field.
- Award one or more

Renewable: Yes

Apply: Contact Mountain State University Scholarship Coordinator for application guidelines.

Ernest and Clara Bailey Memorial

Eligibility

- Full-time WV student enrolled in the Mountain State University nursing program.
- Preference is given to a first generation college student.
- Graduating high school seniors and college upperclassmen may apply.
- One scholarship annually

Renewable: Yes; recipient must re-apply annually, remain full-time in nursing program, and maintain a "B" average.

Apply: Contact Mountain State University Scholarship Coordinator for application guidelines.

Bales Family Scholarship

Eligibility

- Woodrow Wilson High School graduating senior.
- Based on financial need, academic ability, and participation in at least one school activity (sports, band, and clubs).
- One scholarship annually

Renewable: No

Jerry L. and Jean D. Beasley Scholarship

Eligibility

- Non-traditional Raleigh County student at least 25 years of age attending Concord University.

Renewable: Yes

Apply: Contact Concord University Admissions Office and use their application materials.

Brenda Bias Memorial Scholarship

Apply: **Will not accept new applications for the 2010-2011 academic term**

Daniel and Cynthia Bickey Scholarship

Eligibility

- Raleigh County public high school graduate attending a West Virginia college or university.
- One scholarship annually.

Renewable: Yes; must re-apply annually, maintain a 3.2 GPA and remain in school without interruption.

Apply: High School Guidance office and use BAF Application returned to Beckley Area Foundation, 129 Main Street, Ste.203, Beckley, WV 25801.

Dr. A. G. Bowles Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility

- Student attending Mountain State University in field leading to health related career.
- Awarded on the basis of need and academic ability.

Renewable: Yes; must re-apply annually.

Apply: Contact Mountain State University Scholarship Coordinator for application guidelines.

E.V. and Eleanor Bowman Memorial Scholarship for MSU

Eligibility

- Need-based for a Mountain State University student from West Virginia who graduated from a high school in Raleigh, Fayette, Summers, Mercer or Wyoming counties.
- Recipient must have at least a B average in high school.
- One Award

Renewable: Yes; recipient must re-apply annually and maintain at least a 2.0 GPA.

Ernest V. Bowman Memorial Scholarship Fund for Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University

Eligibility

- Graduates of Raleigh, Fayette, Summers, Mercer or Wyoming counties of West Virginia attending VA Tech.
- College upperclassmen (sophomores, juniors, and seniors) who meet other selection criteria may apply as well as graduating seniors.
- Engineering field of study.
- "B" average or better.
- Need based.
- One Award

Renewable: Yes, if fulltime student working toward an engineering degree and maintaining "B" average.

Renewable for four years after the initial award--total assistance of five years.

Apply: Contact Virginia Tech College of Engineering for application details.

Lemma Fink Bowyer Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility

- Scholarship rotates between WV Wesleyan, Glenville State, Shepherd College and Concord University.
- 2010-2011 qualifying school is Glenville State; 2011-2012 Shepherd College
- Qualified deserving female who is a Raleigh or Fayette County high school graduate pursuing an education degree in the Fine Arts or English field.
- Must have full-time enrollment status, be an upperclassman, and reside on campus.
- One Award

Renewable: No

Apply: **Will not accept new applications for the 2010-2011 academic term**

Doris Merchant Bradshaw and Virgil Bradshaw Scholarship

Eligibility

- Raleigh County high school graduate attending a West Virginia college or university pursuing a degree in early childhood education.
- Awarded based upon both need and merit
- One award

Renewable: Yes; must re-apply annual and maintain a B average while classified as a full-time student.

Apply: **Will not accept new applications for the 2010-2011 academic term.**

Dr. Randall Broyles Scholarship

Eligibility

- College qualified graduates of a Raleigh County, WV high school graduate.
- Based on merit and need.
- Essay questions part of application process.
- One award

Renewable: Yes; three additional years if the recipient maintains a 3.0 GPA and carries a full academic load.

Apply: **Will not accept new applications for the 2010-2011 academic term.**

Fred Burroughs Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility

- College qualified graduates of Victory Baptist Academy, Raleigh County, WV
- Merit based to outstanding athlete.
- Award one to male and one to female.

Renewable: No

Byrd-Prillerman High School Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility

- Need-based scholarship for Raleigh County students who live in the "Main Gulf" where the towns of Fireco, Hot Coal, Helen, McAlpin, Stotesbury, Tams, Ury, Amigo, Rhodell, East Gulf, Besco, Mead, Killarney, Pickshin, Slab Fork, Whitby, Winding Gulf, Affinity and Lillybrook once flourished.
- Preference will be given to descendents of individuals who were students or teachers at Byrd Prillerman School.
- One award

Renewable: Not automatically renewable but past recipients may re-apply.

Donaghue Nursing Scholarship

Eligibility

- One or more scholarships for Raleigh Co. high schools graduates who have achieved a satisfactory academic record and are pursuing a nursing career.
- Financial need shall be considered in selection.
- One or more awards

Renewable: Yes; must re-apply annually.

George and Jean Thompson Douglas Scholarship

Eligibility

- Webster County High School graduating senior.
- Attending a four year, accredited college in WV to obtain a baccalaureate degree.
- Based upon academic merit, need and leadership.
- One award

Renewable: Yes; if recipient shows satisfactory progress including but not limited to at least a 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 system with at least carrying 12 credit hours while demonstrating leadership skills, good citizenship and participation in extra-curricular activities.

Eligibility

- Woodrow Wilson High School senior planning to major in math and/or science-related field.
- Award one.

John M. Greenwald Clear Fork District Elementary School Scholarship

Eligibility

- College qualified graduates of a Raleigh County high school who demonstrates good moral character.
- Must have attended Clear Fork District Elementary School for at least three years.
- Award one.

Renewable: Yes; for three years if the student maintains a “B” average and carries a full academic load.

Willa Spangler Grosse Scholarship

Eligibility

- One or more scholarships for of Raleigh County high school graduates with a satisfactory academic record
- Pursuing a nursing career.

Renewable: Yes; must re-apply annually, maintain at least a C average and carry full academic load.

Apply: Contact School Guidance Office for BAF application materials. Return applications to BAF.

William H. Harnsbarger Scholarship

Eligibility

- Mt. Hope High School graduates, who are full-time students in an accredited college or university.
- Applicant must have participated in at least two sports at Mt. Hope High School and a GPA of 3.0.
- One award

Renewable: Yes; must re-apply annually and maintain a GPA of 2.25 for maximum of three years.

Charlene Hart Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility

- College qualified graduates of Liberty High School.
- Need and merit based.
- One award

Renewable: Yes; must re-apply annually and maintain a “B” average with a full academic load.

Henry Herring Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility

- Woodrow Wilson High School graduate pursuing a degree in some field of science.
- One award

Renewable: Yes; must re-apply annually.

Hindson Family Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility

- One scholarship for a graduate of either Oak Hill High School or Fayetteville High School.
- Need-based

Renewable: No

Eligibility

- Woodrow Wilson High School graduate attending either West Virginia University or Concord University

- High School GPA of at least 2.0 but not greater than 3.0.

Eligibility

- Provides scholarship aid for qualifying high school seniors of the Beckley United Methodist Temple.

Independence H.S. Sherman C. Trail Scholarship

Eligibility

- Independence High School graduates attending accredited colleges, universities, vocational schools, or nursing schools.
- Awards are based more on financial need than on academic standing.

Renewable: No

Dan Janutolo Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility

- High school graduate enrolling in nursing program at Mountain State University.
- One award

Renewable: Yes; if recipient maintains a 3.0 GPA and is a full time student in MSU nursing program.

Connie Louise McComb King

Eligibility:

- Mt. Hope High School graduating senior

Eligibility

- Graduate of Woodrow Wilson High School or the Academy of Careers and Technology.
- Recipient must pursue course leading to a degree or certificate from an accredited institution such as college, junior college, trade school, or technical school.
- The primary criterion in awarding this scholarship is the “need” of the beneficiary for funds to continue his/her education.

- Preference will be given first to eligible candidates from Mercer County, WV and secondly to eligible candidates from Raleigh County, WV.

Renewable: Yes, for 8 consecutive regular semesters.

Max Lewin Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility

- Woodrow Wilson High School graduate who demonstrates financial need.
- One award

- Attendance at Daniels Elementary at some time; applicants must indicate what years they attended Daniels.

Eligibility

- Raleigh County, WV high school graduates and
- Attended and completed at least three years at Maxwell Hill Elementary (6th grade plus two additional years)
- Applicants must indicate what years they attended Maxwell Hill
- 50% of the available funds awarded to a male student and 50% to a female student.
- Considerations in awarding are cumulative grade point average and college admission test scores

Eligibility

Eligibility

- Merit based

- Must have actively participated in at least one high school varsity sport

Christie H. Meadows Family

Eligibility

- **First preference** given to a Future Farmers of America student graduating from Shady Spring High School;
- **Second preference** to a Shady Spring High School graduating senior whose parent is, or has been, a school bus driver for the Raleigh County Public Schools;
- **Third preference** to a graduating senior from any Raleigh County high school whose parent is, or has been a school bus driver or school bus mechanic for the Raleigh County Public Schools
- **Fourth preference** to a Raleigh county student pursuing higher education that is considered to be a challenged student (physically, visually, hearing impaired, etc.).

- West Virginia residents attending WVU College of Law, or any other accredited law school

Eligibility

- Fayette County high school graduate.

Eligibility

- One or more four-year scholarships.
- Woodrow Wilson High School graduating senior.
- Overall GPA of 2.5 to 3.5, and is considered college qualified
- The recipient should be someone who, without the scholarship, would otherwise be unable to attend college.
